Notification to Customers and Partners of ESCATEC's Malaysian Business Units (EEM, EDM & EMM)

Further to our communications in March 2020 we would like to inform you of an important update on the situation in our Malaysian Business Units.

As a result of the Malaysian Government's Movement Control Order (MCO) to contain the spread of COVID-19 ESCATEC has been required to stop all non essential manufacturing in Malaysia from midnight 18 March 2020. EEM and EMM have stopped all production until the MCO ends. On 25 March 2020 the Malaysian Government announced an extension to the MCO to 14 April 2020.

Since certain Medical production is classified by the Malaysian Government as essential production, EDM continues the production of essential medical products including parts for ventilators.

From 6th April 2020 EEM and EMM have been given permission to resume a limited amount of production at their factories in Johor Bahru and Penang subject to strict enforcement of social distancing and hygiene precautions and with a significantly reduced workforce.

It is our current expectation that normal production may resume on the 15 April, however we also expect the Government to make further announcements about the MCO on or around 10 April 2020. Our Key Account Managers (KAMs) are contacting EEM and EMM customers to establish your priorities and delivery plans based on the expectation to resume full production on 15 April 2020 .

The situation continues to evolve and any updates will be communicated through further notifications and our web site.

We continue to closely monitor and assess this fast changing situation. We will keep in close contact with our customers if there are changes in the situation. Customers and partners can continue to contact us as usual through email, mobile telephone and other media.
