Notification to Customers and Partners of ESCATEC's Malaysian Business Units (EEM, EDM & EMM)

We would like to inform you of an important update on the situation in our Malaysian Business Units.

As a result of the Malaysian Government's Movement Control Order (MCO) to contain the spread of COVID-19 ESCATEC was required to stop all non essential manufacturing in Malaysia from midnight 18 March 2020. Since certain Medical production is classified by the Malaysian Government as essential production, EDM has continued the production of essential medical products including parts for ventilators.

From 6 April 2020 EEM and EMM were given permission to resume a limited amount of production at their factories in Johor Bahru and Penang subject to strict enforcement of social distancing and hygiene precautions and with a significantly reduced workforce. On 10 April 2020 the Malaysia Government announced an extension to the MCO until 28 April 2020 and on 23 April 2020 a further extension until 12 May 2020 was announced.

On 28 April the Malaysian Government announced that, whilst the MCO continues to be in force, all companies previously given exemptions for limited production can, from 29 April 2020, resume full production subject to continued enforcement of social distancing and hygiene measures. Consequently all ESCATEC's Malaysian Business Units are returning to full time working with 100% of the workforce from 29 April 2020.

The situation continues to evolve and any updates will be communicated through further notifications and our web site.

We continue to closely monitor and assess this fast changing situation. We will keep in close contact with our customers if there are changes in the situation. Customers and partners can continue to contact us as usual through email, mobile telephone and other media.
