Notification to Customers and Partners of ESCATEC's Malaysian Business Units (EEM, EDM & EMM)

We would like to inform you of an important update on the situation in our Malaysian Business Units.

As a result of the Malaysian Government's Movement Control Order (MCO) to contain the spread of COVID-19 ESCATEC was required to stop all non essential manufacturing in Malaysia from midnight 18 March 2020. Since certain Medical production is classified by the Malaysian Government as essential production, EDM continued the production of essential medical products including parts for ventilators.

From 29 April 2020, all ESCATEC's Malaysian Business Units in Penang and Johor Bahru have resumed full production subject to continued enforcement of social distancing and hygiene measures. On 7 June, following a continued downward trend in the infection rate, the Malaysian Government announced the recovery phase of the MCO until 31 August 2020. "Almost all" social, educational, religious and business activities, as well as economic sectors will reopen in phases, with Standard Operating Procedures to be adhered to. Interstate travel is now allowed, except for areas placed under enhanced MCO, while the country's borders remain closed. For now foreign nationals cannot travel to Malaysia and we are not accepting visitors to our Malaysian facilities.

The situation continues to evolve and any updates will be communicated through further notifications and our web site.

We continue to closely monitor and assess this fast changing situation. We will keep in close contact with our customers if there are changes in the situation. Customers and partners can continue to contact us as usual through email, mobile telephone and other media.
