Notification to Customers and Partners
of ESCATEC's Malaysian Business Units (EEM & EDM)

We would like to inform you of an update on the situation in our Malaysian Business Units in Penang.

From 6th November until 19th November 2020, ESCATEC's Malaysian Business Units in Penang will be participating in a Government stipulated Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO), which has been implemented as a precautionary measure to stop the possibility of spreading Covid 19 in our local district of Bayan Lepas, where the majority of foreign workers are housed in relatively close proximity. Therefore, the Government has taken early and swift action to safeguard the industrial zone, where the majority of manufacturers are based in Penang Island. There are 26 active cases in the district as of 4th November 2020, and have been a total of 69 cases since the beginning of the Covid 19 outbreak.

Our operations are working at full capacity, and there will be zero impact to your business.

We continue to closely monitor the situation and we will keep in close contact with our customers if there are any changes. Customers and partners can continue to contact us as usual through email, mobile telephone and other media.
