Notification to Customers and Partners of ESCATEC's Malaysian Business Units (EEM, EDM, ETM, EMM)

With reference to our previous notifications dated 12 January 2021 (ref: Malaysia has re-imposed a "Movement Control Order") and dated 3 February 2021 (ref: Malaysia has extended its "Movement Control Order" to 18 February 2021).

Please be advised that the Malaysian government has extended its "Movement Control Order" (MCO) to 4 March 2021 for the states of Selangor, Johor, Penang, and the Federal Territory of Kuala Lumpur. ESCATEC Electronics, ESCATEC Medical and ESCATEC Technology are based in the global electronics cluster of Bayan Lepas, Penang, while ESCATEC Mechatronics is in the southern city of Johor Bahru, Johor.

Most economic sectors nationwide are operating - subject to strict Health & Safety SOPs - and this will continue, even in the states covered by the new extension of the MCO. However, inter-state and inter-district travel is still not permitted nationwide.

Our Malaysian business units in Penang and Johor will continue to operate as scheduled during this new extension of the MCO. However, with very strict internal H&S SOPs in place, we remain unable to receive visitors at all our Malaysian facilities until further notice.

The Malaysian government has also announced a "National COVID-19 Immunisation Programme" that will run in stages from end February 2021 to February 2022. The first stage covers Healthcare & Enforcement front-liners, followed by vulnerable people and the third stage, beginning May 2021, is for everyone else.
