Notification to Customers and Partners of ESCATEC's Malaysian Business Units (EEM, EDM, ETM, EMM)

We would like to inform our customers and partners of the latest developments relating to the current "Movement Control Order" (MCO) in Malaysia.

Due to the increasing number of COVID19 cases in the country, the Prime Minister of Malaysia on 21 May 2021 announced that the current iteration of the MCO, referred to as MCO3.0, would be further tightened effective 25 May 2021. Subsequently, the Ministry of International Trade & Industry Malaysia (MITI) released updated SOPs on 24 May 2021 detailing the measures that industries would henceforth need to comply with.

Specifically relating to manufacturing, the enhanced MCO3.0 states that factories can continue to operate on a 24/7 basis, with the proviso that 40% of the total employee headcount must work from home at any given time. ESCATEC's Malaysian business units (i.e., ESCATEC Electronics, ESCATEC Medical and ESCATEC Mechatronics) have been practising a Work-from-Home policy as much as possible for its office and management staff. Nonetheless, the requirements of the enhanced MCO3.0 means that a greater number of ESCATEC employees will have to Work-from-Home.

We are managing the situation to minimise any impact on customer deliveries and your Key Account Manager will contact you if we foresee any changes to our delivery commitments.

Please note that due to our stringent Health & Safety SOPs, our facilities in Malaysia remain unable to receive visitors.

We continue to closely monitor and assess the situation and will keep our customers and partners updated of developments. Please do get in touch with your ESCATEC contact in case of further questions or enquiries.
